## KEEP SICK KIDS HOME

When in doubt, stay at home...

If your child is not feeling well, please do not send them to school.

If your student is sent home with any of the following symptoms, they will be required to stay out 48 hours symptom free without the use of medication:

- fever 100.4 or higher
- cough chills/ body aches
- sore throat
- vomiting
- loss of taste/smell
- headache
- stomach pain / nausea
- nasal congestion/drainage

Please notify your physician if symptoms worsen, you are concerned about Covid-19, OR if your child has been exposed to someone who has tested positive. If your child has a Covid-19 test, tests positive, or has been in close contact with someone who has tested positive, please notify the school.
